There's so many blessings tied into praising God that you'll probably be amazed.

But one point I'd like to make right now is this.

Praising God is the most powerful form of prayer there is, period.

If you don't do nothing else for the kingdom of God, I would suggest that you at least learn how to praise the lord.

Therefore, the three things you need to do in order to keep the sabbath day holy is, stop finding your own pleasure, call the sabbath a delight, and call the lord honorable.

Here, read it for yourself.

Isaiah 54:13-14 If thou turn away thy foot from the

sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.
