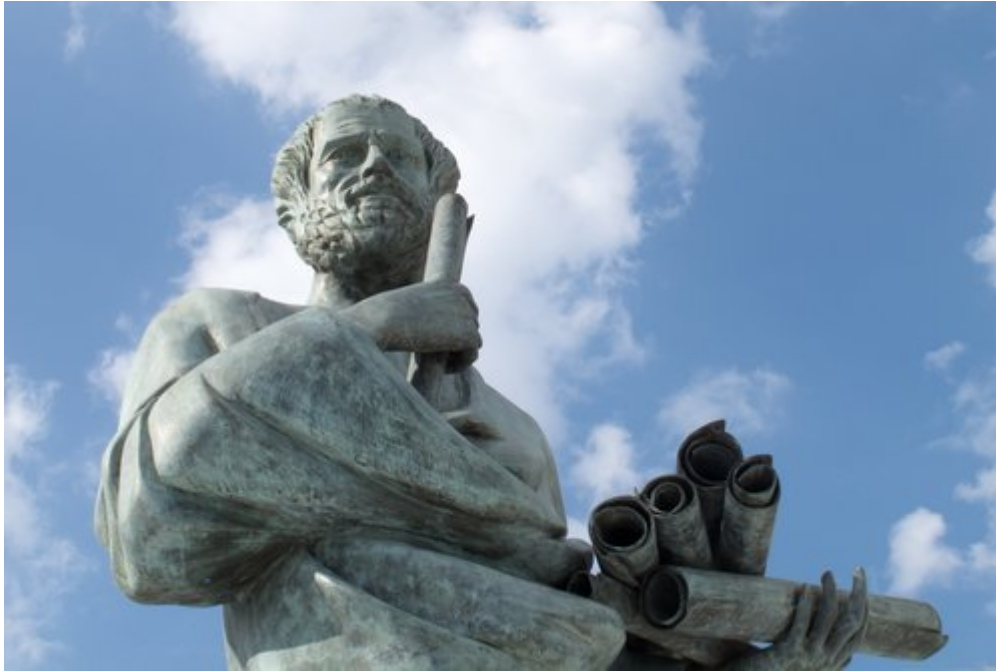


Does Your Philosophy Agree With Bible Philosophy?
